CIS pedagogy is informed by worldwide research and evidence along with Dr. Gandhi's own research in the UK, Iceland and India, published in the UK in 2017.

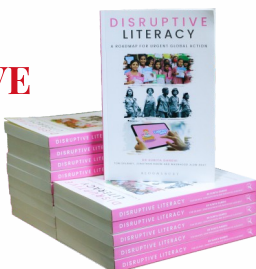

Jon Corippo's Session at City International School

On February 3-4, 2022 City International School hosted an impeccable session on learning redefined by World Renowned Educational Influencer Jon Corippo from the United States. Jon served as the Chief Learning Officer for CUE for over half a decade, leading the training of over 60,000 educators in the last 5 years. On day 1, Jon was in conversation with the teachers at City International School, Manas Vihar and introduced them to the structured framework of Edu protocol, using technology in

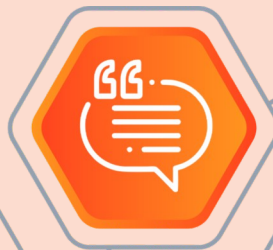

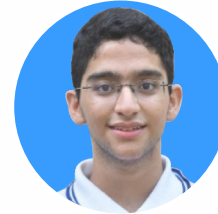
